Your Role:

You will play a key role in the technical support provided to productions at the Met providing excellent customer service to hirers, promoters, artists and community groups.

You will support the Technical and Production Manager to ensure that safe and effective technical practices are developed and implemented ensuring that best practice and legislative requirements are followed.

In this role, you will:

- Lead on the delivery of live events at the Met.
- Assist visiting companies, crews and community users including supervising casual staff and ensuring the working area is used safely and professionally at all times
- Under the direction of the Technical and Production Manager working to both planned and reactive scheduling of annual works to ensure all theatre equipment stays in safe, working condition.
- Work with the General Manager of the Met to ensure smooth technical operational management of the programme of events.
- Contribute and participate in regular reviews of health and safety policies and procedures.
- Participate in departmental meetings as required, to ensure high quality technical delivery for all productions / events at the venues.

- Set up, running and troubleshooting, when necessary, all aspects of technical operation across, lighting, sound stage and AV.
- Undertake health and safety checks, fire compliance, testing and training.
- Act as key holder for buildings when required, taking part in the opening / closing and duty cover in liaison with the General Manager.
- Recognise and keep up to date with industry best practice.
